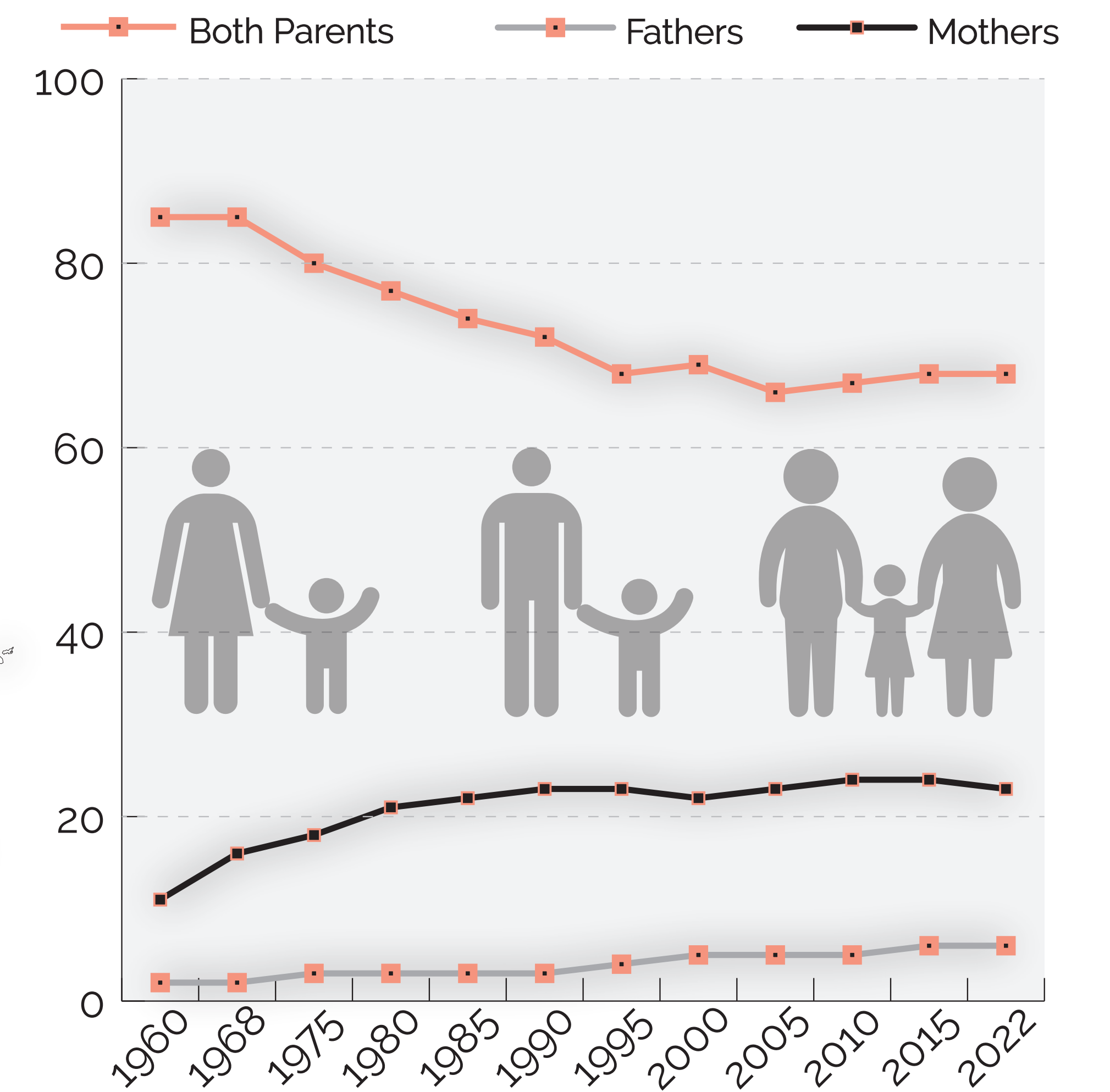
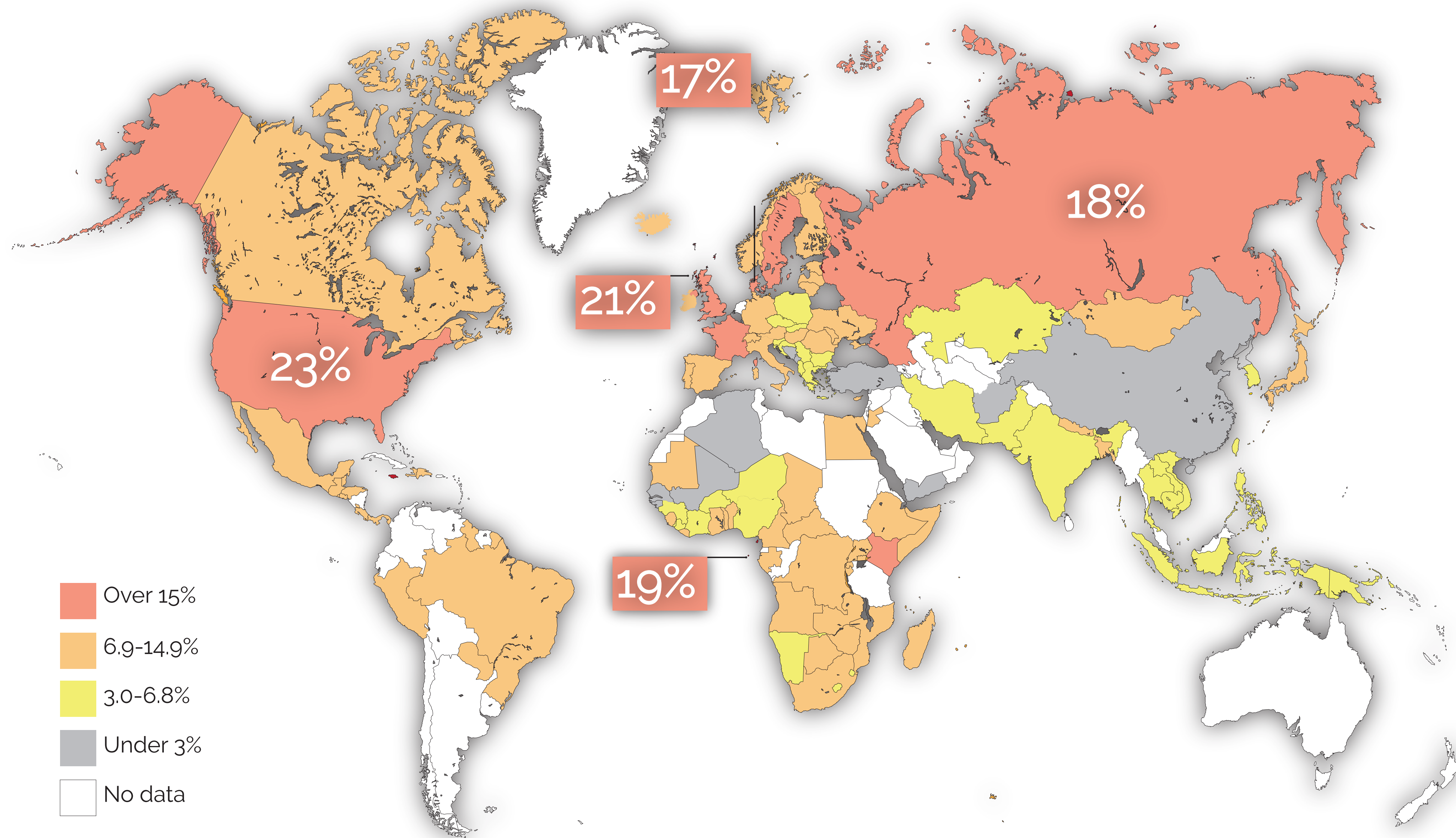


Single-parent children by demographic in the U.S.

Single parents in the U.S. by gender

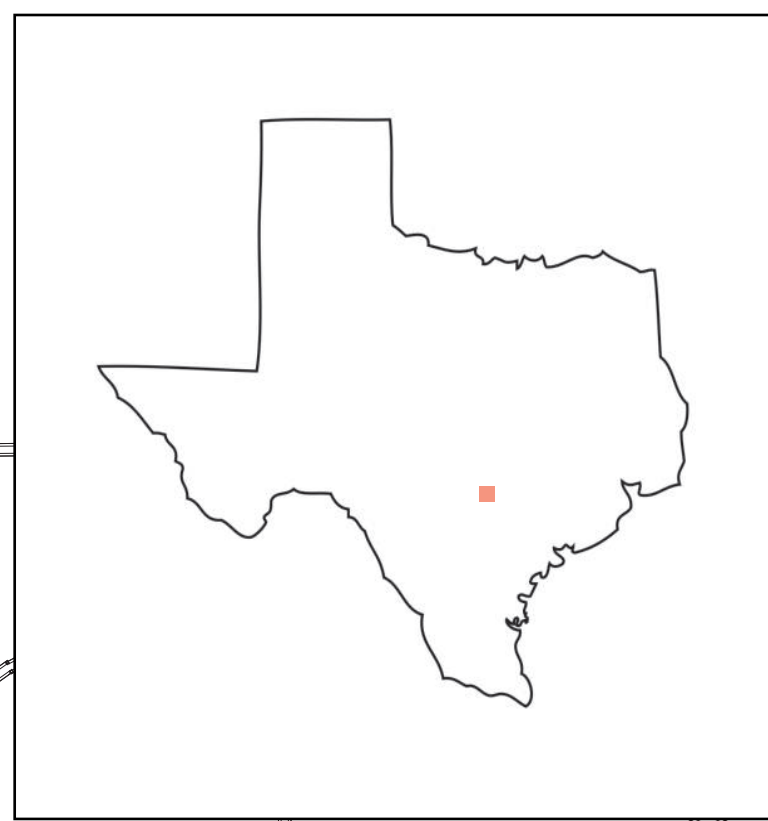

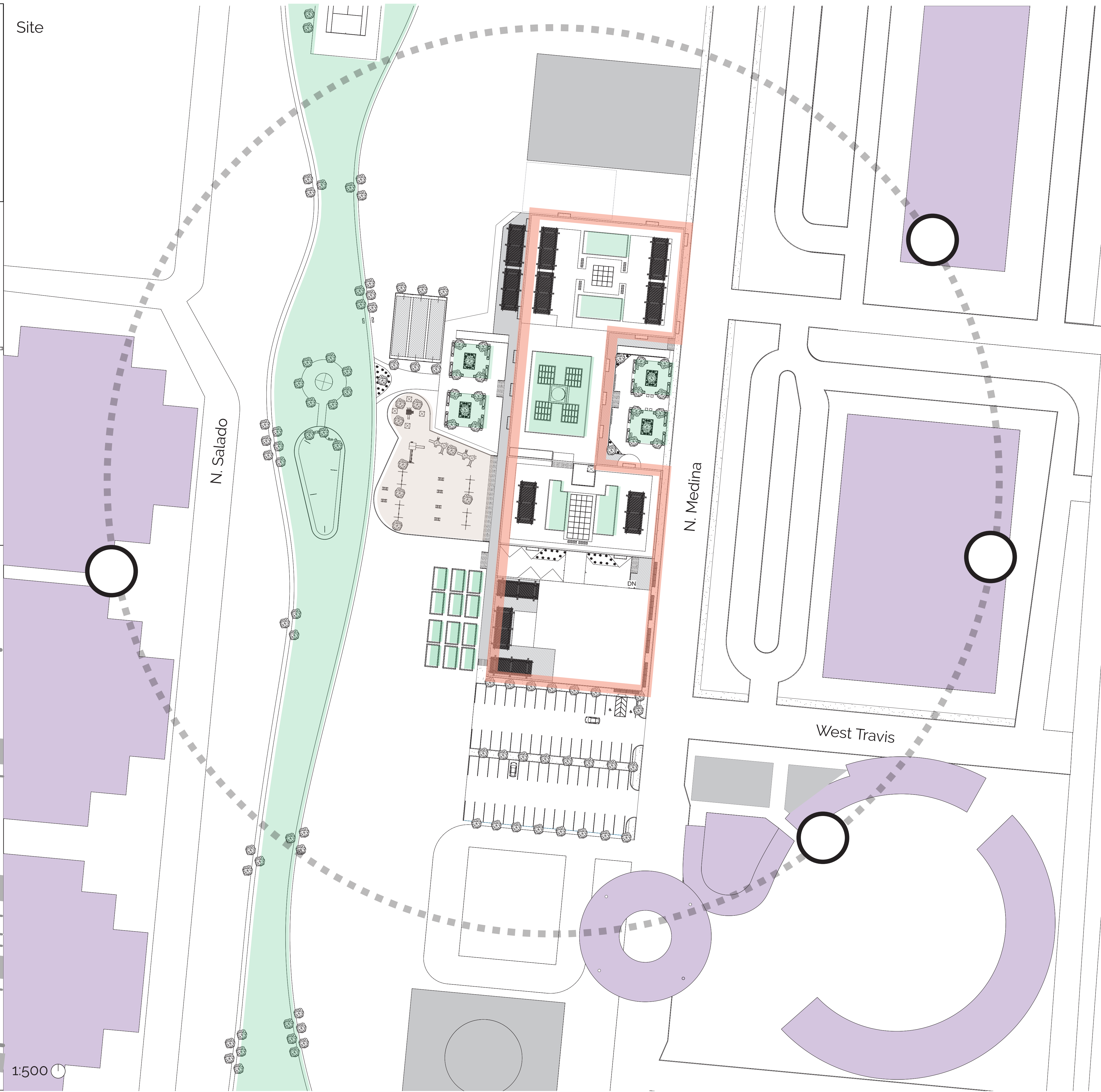
The U.S. ranks first out of the five highest concentrations of single-parent households in the World

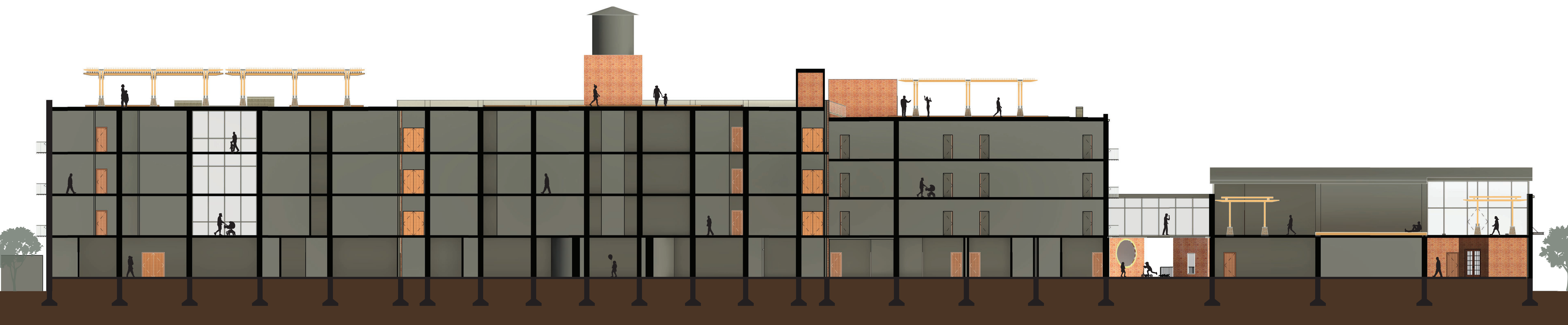
